ALLOWING EMERGENCY RELIEF TO MARTIN COUNTY


This Court, having being advised by Martin County Clerk of the Court Marsha Stiller that due to environmental problems in the Martin County Courthouse it will be necessary to give temporary relief from Administrative Order 75-2 during actual criminal trials in that only one clerk will be available to monitor, log, and clerk for the Court, and pursuant to Rule 2.050, Florida Rules of Judicial Administration it is therefore:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

The Martin County Clerk of the Court is authorized to provide only one clerk to monitor, log and clerk during actual criminal trials unless the presiding judge orders otherwise.

This will remain in effect until normal operations resume.
