

The Supreme Court of Florida having from time to time amended the Florida Rules of Practice and Procedure for Traffic Courts providing therein court cost limits conditional upon administrative orders of the chief judges of the respective circuit, and in order to avoid multiplicity of said orders, it is

ORDERED that the Clerks of the Circuit Court of Indian River, Martin, Okeechobee, and Saint Lucie Counties, Florida, are authorized to assess court costs in the maximum amount presently set or that may hereafter be set in Rules 6.291(b) and 6.470(b) of the Rules of Practice and Procedure for Traffic Courts.
