ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 89-2

Pursuant to Section 39.12(4), Florida Statutes (1987),
The Florida Center for Children and Youth, Inc. and its
authorized representatives and subcontractors shall be per-
mitted to have access to all confidential records of jail
inmates admitted to any jail in the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit
in the year 1988 whose age at the time of admission was
18 years or younger. Such access shall include the specific
names of juveniles held in jail during the subject period.

The data collected pursuant to this order shall be used
exclusively for the "Florida Juvenile Justice Compliance
Project" and in accordance with the approval letter from the
Department of Health and Rehabilitative Services
