
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 92-10

Pursuant to directive from the Supreme Court of Florida (598 So 2d 41) a
Circuit Pro Bono committee for the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit is hereby
established to develop the Circuit's voluntary pro bono plan. The Committee shall
discharge all additional responsibilities imposed by the pro bono rules.

The Circuit Pro Bono Committee shall be composed of the following:

- (a) Chief Judge or designee
- (b) Presidents of all local bar associations within the Nineteenth Judicial
Circuit
- (c) Florida Rural Legal Services, Inc.
- (d) A lay person and at least one client eligible person, all of whom are to
be chosen by committee members named in (a) through (c) above.
