WHEREAS the National Weather Service has placed all of the Counties of the Circuit under Hurricane Warning Conditions and whereas Law Enforcement has ordered an evacuation of large segments of the populace and land areas to keep potential hazards to a minimum and for the security and safety of the public,

THEREFORE as Chief Judge, pursuant to Rule 2.050 of the Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, the Courthouses of the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit are closed for business on Monday, August 24, 1992 except for emergency matters.
