ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 93-01


WHEREAS, the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA) requires that reasonable accommodations be provided to requesting qualified persons with disabilities in order that they might participate fully in court programs, services, activities, and benefits; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit to facilitate provision of reasonable accommodations when requested by qualified persons with disabilities;

IT IS ORDERED that all communications noticing court proceedings include the following language;

"In accordance with the Americans With Disabilities Act, persons needing a special accommodation to participate in this proceeding should contact Court Administration not later than seven days prior to the proceeding at 229 Courthouse Addition, 218 South Second Street, Ft. Pierce, FL 34950, (407) 468-1472; 1-(800) 955-8771 (TDD), or 1-(800) 955-8770 (V), via Florida Relay Service."
