RE: AMENDED BOND SCHEDULE
 DOMESTIC VIOLENCE CASES

The Domestic Violence Task Force of the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit has recommended that a uniform no bond until first appearance policy be implemented in Domestic Violence cases within the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit. Therefore as Chief Judge of the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit and pursuant to Florida Rules of Administrative Procedure 2.050, it is Ordered:

Within the 19th. Circuit any person charged with assault and battery in association with a "Domestic Violence" matter shall have NO BOND SET until the First Appearance Hearing.

Pursuant to changes in Florida Statutes 784.046 any person charged with violation of an Injunction for Protection shall have NO BOND SET until the First Appearance Hearing.
